What is it?

A pattern of control in which individuals interfere with their partner's ability to build, use, and maintain their career and earnings.



Why should you care?

68%

of teens surveyed experienced some form of control or interference with their education

67%

of teens surveyed experienced some form of control or interference with employment

65%

of teens surveyed experienced some form of financial control or exploitation

How to teach about TEA

- Understand that this topic may be touchy
- Discuss examples of TEA, from red flags to drastic situations
- Include statistics that bring life into the issue
- Emphasize lasting impacts of TEA on careers and education
- Recognize that your teens have real jobs with real income
- Offer solutions and resources
